

Tent Pole Materials and Spare-Parts Questions for Buyers

A product-manager brief for comparing tent pole material records and requesting model-specific replacement-part details.

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TL;DR

A tent pole material name is not a replacement specification. First record the exact tent model and variant, then collect each pole's material as stated, segment count, assembled and segment lengths, outer diameter, connector and tip form, quantity, and clear photos. Seawing publishes fiberglass on selected automatic tents and iron plus fiberglass on a separate villa-tent record; compatibility, grade, stock and warranty must be confirmed for the selected configuration.

Separate material labels from a fit decision

Material is one field in a pole assembly. A product manager also needs the actual frame layout, each segment and ferrule, hub or tip, length and diameter, attachment method and revision. A fiberglass or metal label alone cannot establish strength, durability, replacement fit or a safe substitution.

The published two-door/two-window large variant lists 7.9 mm fiberglass automatic poles. The square-tent variants list 8.5 mm fiberglass automatic rods. A separate HILLTOP PRO villa-tent record lists iron and fiberglass poles. These are record-specific statements, not interchangeable assemblies or an offer of stocked spare parts.

Compare what is published with what is missing

A material comparison becomes useful only when the buyer captures the entire model-specific assembly.

Compare what is published with what is missing

Selected reference	Published material field	Missing information to request
Two-door/two-window large variant	7.9 mm fiberglass automatic poles listed	Model/revision, segment count, length, connector and tip form, assembly drawing.
Automatic square tent	8.5 mm fiberglass rods listed for its two variants	Which variant, which rod position, finished lengths and exact connection parts?
HILLTOP PRO villa tent	Iron and fiberglass pole materials listed	Which members use each material, dimensions, joint forms and the approved parts list?

A replacement request has three layers

Identity Model and revision Find the label, purchase record and current drawing.	Geometry Segments and joints Count, measure and photograph the assembly and damaged position.
Fulfilment Confirm availability Ask for approved part, lead time, quantity and terms; do not assume stock.	

Documentation workflow, not a statement that replacement stock or cross-model compatibility exists.

Product images are orientation aids

These are site-hosted catalogue references. Visible rods or supports help identify a tent family; image appearance cannot determine alloy grade, wall thickness, fit or spare-part availability.



Square-tent reference: the listed fiberglass frame and foyer supports need separate part identification.



A separate hexagonal reference shows parts visually; do not transfer their size or compatibility.

A pole or spare-part enquiry form

Send one brief per model and variant; measure the actual part or use an approved drawing.

A pole or spare-part enquiry form

Block	Include	Why it matters
Tent identity	Model/SKU, variant, year or revision, order reference	Similar product names can hide different frames.
Part map	Pole position, segment count, quantity and damage location	Identifies the specific assembly.
Measurements	Assembled/segment lengths, outer diameter, connector, ferrule and tip form	Tests fit against the approved drawing.

Block	Include	Why it matters
Evidence and request	Photos with scale, label, destination, required quantity and timing	Lets the supplier confirm an approved part, availability and terms.

How to resolve a pole question

- 1

Identify the tent

Record exact model, variant and revision.
- 2

Map the pole

Count sections and identify each joint and end.
- 3

Document dimensions

Measure safely and attach clear scaled photos.
- 4

Ask for confirmation

Request approved part number, fit, stock status, timing and warranty terms for this case.

How to resolve a pole question

Original maintenance guidance has limits

REI's pole-repair guide separates an emergency sleeve from a proper replacement and explains how to preserve section order. Tarptent's own pole listings show that diameter, length, tip and model vary even within one brand. TentPole Technologies' repair form asks for model, name and year. OIA's Q2 2026 U.S. retail summary notes gear-maintenance interest but proves no Seawing parts demand or inventory.

For tent dimensions and interior geometry, read the usable-floor-area guide. For the tent family itself, use the category page and identify the exact record before a part enquiry.

Request the selected tent specifications

Frequently Asked Questions

Does fiberglass tell me which replacement pole fits?

No. Match the exact model and revision, geometry, diameter, lengths, joints and tips against an approved parts record.

Are 7.9 mm and 8.5 mm rods interchangeable?

No interchangeability is established by these published records. Request model-specific fit confirmation.

Does Seawing guarantee spare poles in stock?

No stock or lead-time promise is made here. Ask for availability and terms for the selected part.

What photos should accompany a request?

Include the tent label, full pole assembly, damaged position, both ends, connectors and a scale beside measured segments.

Does a repair sleeve replace a proper part?

REI describes a sleeve as a field repair. Ask for an approved model-specific replacement and appropriate instructions before normal use.
